2. To see if the town will approve by ballot vote the following ordinance (RSA 31:39):

No person shall permit their land to be used for the disposal, application, composting, treatment, storage, processing or collection of septage or sludge generated from a public or private waste water treatment facility.

A fine may be levied not to exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for each act constituting a violation of this ordinance. (RSA 149-M:13).

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its enactment.

- 5. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) to be added to the Rescue Unit vehicle and equipment Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The selectmen and the budget committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 6. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to be added to the Fire Truck and equipment Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The selectmen and the budget committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 7. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) to be added to the Revaluation of Town Property Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The selectmen and the budget committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 8. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to be added to the Huntress Bridge Maintenance and Painting Capital Reserve Fund previously established. The selectmen and the budget committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 9. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$5,200.00) for a personal allotment for Effingham Fire Fighters. The selectmen recommend this appropriation. The budget committee does not recommend \$200.00 of this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$2,600.00) for a personal allotment for Effingham Rescue Squad members. The selectmen recommend this appropriation. The budget committee does not recommend \$100.00 of this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 11. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for renovations and/or repairs to the Fire Stations and parking lots. The selectmen and the budget committee recommend this appropriation. (Majority vote required).
- 12. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be placed in the existing Emergency Management/Disaster Expendable General Fund Trust with the selectmen as agents to expend. Effingham Planning Board Report for 1996

This past year was a very busy and informative one for the Planning Board. Although the board approved only three subdivisions, there were many other land use issues that we spent considerable time studying and discussing. Two of the most notable issues were the town's Steep Slopes Ordinance and the Subdivision Regulations concerning multi-unit dwellings.

The board sought legal assistance on both these matters. Under the present law for the State of New Hampshire, a town without a zoning ordinance has very little control over land use. Other than the act of subdividing, a planning board cannot control land use issues.

These issues, along with updating the town's Master Plan, will be top priorities for the planning board in 1997. The board plans to hold several hearings on these issues in the near future. We urge the residents and property owners of Effingham to attend these hearings to provide the board with ideas.

Beyond working on regular planning business, many members attended several planning workshops, seminars and law lectures sponsored by the Lakes Region Planning Commission, New Hampshire Municipal Association and the New Hampshire Office of State Planning.

Effingham Historic District Commission

During the eleven meetings held in 1996, our proceedings included consideration of issues relating to the preservation of natural-landscape characteristics in our town. One addressed concerns of residents about the means to protect two triangles. This interest centered on the triangle at the entrance to Hobbs Road which houses the First Normal School Plaque and the triangle at the junction of Old Pound Road and Town House Road. Over time, both sites had been severely disordered and undermined by snow-removal and road-maintenance operations. Following review and with the cooperation of the selectmen and the N. H. Department of Transportation, additional conservation guidelines to protect these significant settings have been put into effect.

Another similar project related to the stewardship of historic resources along the Scenic Road. During the past year, stonewalls, boundary lines, trees and roadside edges along this way were damaged by logging activities. Each of these natural elements has significant affect upon the visual impact of the roadway and concerns about destructive practices were addressed. To protect these features from further encroachment and to effect restoral of the natural state of the area, logging operators were provided with in-depth information to enable them to be in compliance with town and state regulations.

The completion of the Town House restoration has been an ascendant Commission agenda commitment for some time and we are pleased that the Historical Society has advised that the work will be completed this spring. This accomplishment will be especially appreciated for the building is an extraordinary monument of the history of the Town of Effingham.

"Preserving New Hampshire's Past to Enhance its Future" is the motto of the statewide preservation organization, Inherit New Hampshire. Recently, the Chairman of its Board gave a speech in which the essential message was as follows:

Historic buildings frame our New Hampshire lifestyle. They are the backdrop to our lives. They are an integral part of what makes this state such a great place to live, and when we lose too much of our historic architecture, our quality of life suffers too. If historic buildings frame our lifestyle, then everybody has a vested interest in preservation.

The Commission welcomes those who have questions, concerns or comments to share with us on how we may further serve in matters relating to our function to attend our meetings which take place the second Thursday of each month at 7:30 p. m.

The Effingham Fire Dept purchased the following. Class A Foam to aid in fire suppression, 2 new nozzles, upgraded part of the member turn out gear, Added 2 new SCBA'S 2 spare bottles, salvage covers and floor runners. Installed a new overhead door, and paved one side of Parking lot at Station # 2.

The dept continued it's membership in NFPA and updated the NFPA codes manuals.

The new piece of Fire apparatus arrived in Effingham in mid September from Centeral States Fire Apparatus Co. Many hours of training were conducted on the new piece of Fire Apparatus .

The new Apparatus is a 1996 Freightliner FL 80 , Diesel engine with an Automatic Transmission .

We were ably assisted during 1996 by mutual aid services from surrounding communities and Lords Ambulance.

During 1996, Effingham Rescue responded to over 90 calls for medical assistance. We continue to strive to improve our response time and to always maintain the high quality of medical care that the townspeople of Effingham have come to expect.

ANNUAL REPORT 1996

The Visiting Nurse Association-Hospice of Southern Carroll County and Vicinity, Inc. better known as the VNA-Hospice, has had an extremely busy year since I was appointed the Executive Director in September of 1995. The Agency has made a total of 44,938 home visits which is a 12.2% growth. The Agency's budget is now more than \$2,500,000.00 which now classifies the V.N.A.-Hospice as a medium sized HomeCare Agency. There are officially 97 employees, most of whom are part time. During 1996 the Agency celebrated its Golden Anniversary as a not-for-profit HomeCare Organization.

The following services were provided to the residents of Effingham between October 1, 1995 and September 30, 1996. This represents 4% of all the services provided by the VNA-Hospice

Besides Effingham, the VNA-Hospice provides service to the residents of Alton, Brookfield, Ossipee, Sandwich, Tuftonboro, Wolfeboro and Wakefield. We have also helped the HomeCare Agencies in Moultonboro, Tamworth, Freedom, Madison, Milton, Albany and Middleton to provide services to their residents.

The VNA-Hospice is a not-for profit, equal opportunity employer, located in Wolfeboro at Huggins Hospital. The staff located in the office include Administrative, Secretarial and Financial people. The people who work directly in the home include Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses, Certified Nurses Assistants, Physicians, Homemakers and Social Workers, they also include Physical, Speech and Occupational Therapists. The Agency uses the services of many, many volunteers who work on the Board of Directors, on Committees, in the office and directly with our patients, their services are essential to our operation and are greatly appreciated.

VNA-Hospice has three major programs that are offered throughout our service area, including our Home Health Care Program, our Outpatient-Maternal Child Health Program and our Hospice Program. Through these programs we are able to provide services in your home such as Skilled Nursing Care, including some High Technological care such as Intravenous Therapy and Pain Control Therapy. We provide Home Health Aide Care, Homemaking, Physical Therapy, Speech Therapy, Occupational Therapy and Social Work. We also provide Well Child Clinics,

Immunization Clinics and Flu Shot Clinics throughout our area. VNA-Hospice also provides counseling and support sessions in the area of bereavement. We provide a Sudden Death Response Team to help survivors get through the crisis. The Agency provides formal educational programs such as our Volunteer Training Courses and our AIDS Seminar. Administrative Staff Members willingly have done public speaking engagements, and have lead discussion groups on any of our programs or on the Medicare/ Medicaid Benefit.

During the next year the VNA-Hospice will be able to provide Psychiatric Nursing Care and even more High Technological services in the home. During 1995, in collaboration with Huggins Hospital, we applied for and were awarded two grants to establish a Good Beginnings Program, which will enable us to provide services to any newborn and their family in our service area. The VNA-Hospice is one of the major Health Care providers in this region, and it is essential that we are able to meet the needs of our communities. This Agency is committed to you, and we anticipate collaborating with other health care providers in this region to come up with different systems of providing services to you, that will be more efficient and cost effective. We will continue to work with all Local, State, Federal and Third Party Payors to meet your needs.

We receive most of our funding from Medicare/Medicaid, other insurances, fees collected, and Grants from the New Hampshire Bureau of Maternal and Child Health. The VNA-Hospice is very dependent on our fund drives, our donations and our town appropriation funds, which enable us to continue to provide non-refundable services to those patients who need them.

In accordance with New Hampshire Statutory Requirements regulating certain Transactions involving Directors of Charitable Trusts (RSA 7:19-a), the VNA-Hospice is making known that Dr. Eric Lewis, who is a voting member of the Board of Directors is also an Employee of the Agency. He serves as the Medical Director of the Hospice and Maternal Child Health Programs and receives fiscal compensation for these services.

The Board of Directors, the staff and I thank you for your continued support.

LAKES REGION PLANNING COMMISSION

The Lakes Region Planning Commission is a voluntary, non-profit association of local governments formed for the purpose of bringing area municipalities together. By associating and pooling resources, local governments have access to a highly trained professional staff for a wide variety of services. The LRPC works to benefit the member communities and the region overall. The LRPC has expertise in land use and transportation planning, master planning, environmental planning, capital improvement programming, economic and community development, housing, fiscal and environmental impact analysis, geographic information systems, household hazardous waste collections, engineering and site plan review. Circuit rider planning and public facilitation services are also available from the Commission.

Your support helps the LRPC maintain a regional presence working on behalf of all local governments in the Lakes Region. Over the past year the LRPC:

- Provided consultation and technical assistance to thirty-one member communities.
- Co-hosted three public Municipal Law Lectures where practicing attorneys provide a legal perspective on local planning, zoning and other municipal issues.
- Presented a public workshop for local land use and select boards on home occupations
 where attorneys and planners participated in a panel discussion on this rapidly growing
 economic and land use activity.
- Convened a public workshop on the basics of planning for planning board members and others who needed an introduction or refresher seminar on the dynamics and responsibilities of the local planning process.
- Convened four public meetings to receive public comment as part of the update to the Lakes Region Transportation Plan. The Transportation Plan is the policy document which supports additions to the regional and state transportation improvement programs.
- Completed Phase 2 of the Route 16 Corridor Study and initiated work on the analysis and recommendations aspects of Phase 3.
- Represented the Region on the N.H. Heritage Trail Advisory Committee.
- Continued to update the regional land use map using geographic information system technology. Land use for Franklin, Laconia, Gilford, Tilton, Meredith and Hill was completed last year; more communities will be added in the next year.

- Continued to support area economic development policy as a board member of the Belknap County Economic Development Council and Newfound Economic Development Corporation Mitigation Fund Advisory Committee. Applied for regional funding to support economic development from the NH Community Development Finance Authority.
- Produced and distributed newsletters focusing on planning topics and issues relevant to the Lakes Region.
- Represented the region in discussions leading to the construction of an access road to Governor's State Park along Lake Winnisquam as a member of the Governor's State Park Advisory Committee.
- Served as the Lakes Region's data clearinghouse for U.S. Census, demographic and statistical data. These data are available to community officials and the public.
- Retained regional interest in locating a state sponsored conference facility in the Lakes Region.
- Developed public information materials, e.g., brochure, display, draft map guide and slide show, as part of a major effort to educate the public about nonpoint source pollution in the Lake Winnipesaukee watershed.
- Provided support to the U.S. Americorps staff who focused on working with local land owners on issues related to water quality and land management.
- As part of the NH Rivers Management and Protection Program, the LRPC contacted study area towns to establish the Pemigewasset River Advisory Committee.
- Performed substantial work on a report that compares single-day household hazardous waste (HHW) collections with permanent HHW collection facilities.
- Established subareas of the Lakes Region as forums to discuss regional planning issues.
- ** Coordinated the 12th annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection, the largest single day, multi-site collection in New Hampshire.
